- Starting Tuesday, September 11 at 6:30 p.m. and Wednesday, September 12 at 10:00 a.m., Pastor Lynn will lead us in a 7 week bible study/ book discussion, “The Prodigal God: Recovering the Heart of the Christian Faith” by Timothy Keller. “Taking his trademark intellectual approach to understanding Christianity, Timothy Keller uncovers the essential message of Jesus, locked inside his most familiar parable.
